



<u>Aspire Higher Plus Mentoring Programme Referral Form</u>

<u>Thank you for taking part in Live Unlimited's Aspire Higher Plus Mentoring programme!</u>

Aspire Higher Plus is a 6-month mentoring programme commissioned by Live Unlimited and provided by LKM Coaching to deliver comprehensive employment support, boost confidence & self-esteem and provide work experience opportunities to Barnet's looked after children and care leavers.

The facilitating mentor who will deliver this programme is Lydia McDowall, who has been involved with coaching and mentoring for eight years. Lydia is an Accredited Practitioner Coach and experienced Mentor and was inspired to become a coach/mentor after she was given the opportunity to receive coaching herself. Lydia has supported many clients and has had the pleasure of supporting young people to navigate their choices, develop their skills and establish the right path to reach their goals.

Who is the programme for?

The programme provides 1-2-1 tailored mentorship and support for care experienced young people aged 16-25 years old who are EET (in education, employment, or training) and are seeking routes into employment, wanting promotions or who are in work but looking to change roles or professions, as well as those in training or education and want to know the range of jobs available within their subject choice/field of study.

Applicants must be aged between 16 to 25 and either currently in the care, or previously have been in the care of the London Borough of Barnet.

How will the programme work?

The programme will be delivered through weekly virtual & monthly face to face appointments agreed in advance between mentor and mentee. Each mentee will be required to complete a mentee agreement form which includes programme guidelines as well as mutually agreed goals.

Mentees will receive tailored support around identifying their key skills and strengths, CV writing, application & supporting letter writing, exercises for character building, interview techniques as well as how to be successful in job seeking and promotions. The mentor will help to facilitate potential paid and unpaid work opportunities in the mentee's chosen area

of interest, as well as help build their LinkedIn profile. The mentee may additionally receive guided assignments to complete as homework.

How long is the programme for?

The programme will run for a total of 26-weeks.

Applicants placed on the scheme will be required to sign a pledge as well as demonstrate their ability to stay committed for the duration of the programme.

NB: Applicants will be required to engage in a minimum of one session of Live Unlimited's Care Experienced Expert Panel where they will be given the opportunity to gain skills for their CV, meet new people, and feel empowered to use their voice to make a difference and help shape our schemes.

Applicants will be also given the opportunity to become an Ambassador for Live Unlimited.

Applicants will be required to demonstrate their ability to commit to the programme by providing a schedule/timetable of their work/training patterns. In addition, applicants will be required to adhere to the terms of our mentor/mentee agreement form and any breaches of the terms may result in the applicant being removed from the programme. If you/they are able and agree to commit to 2-hour weekly sessions plus occasional homework time for 26 weeks, please complete our pledge of commitment.
